2) Public confrontation

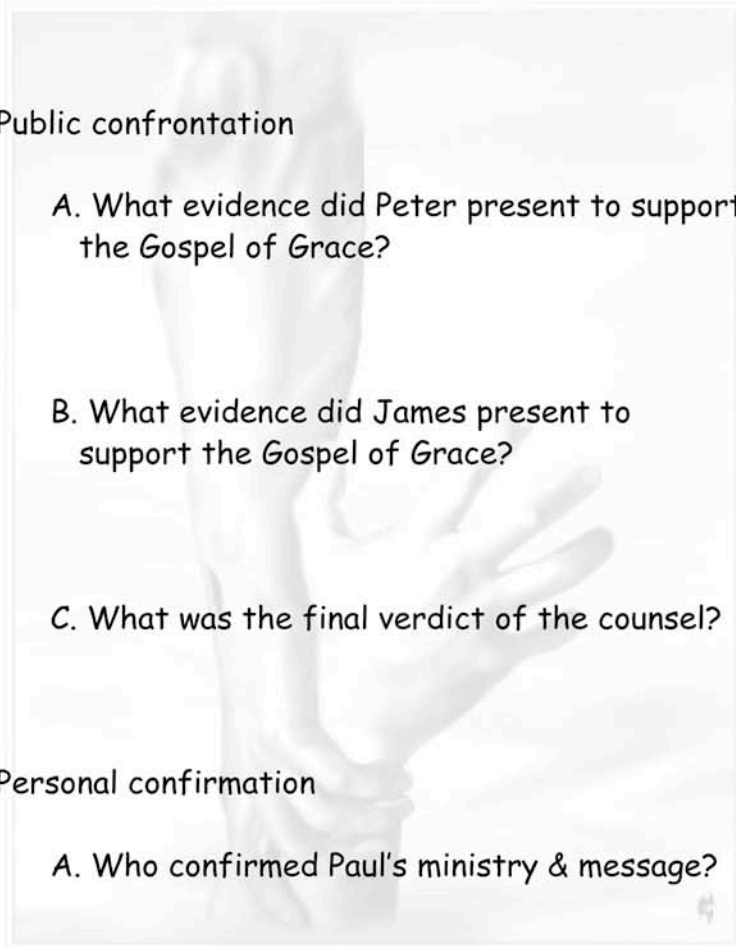
A. What evidence did Peter present to support the Gospel of Grace?
