

# ARE YOU READY FOR THE KING?

Luke 19:28-44; Daniel 9:24-27; 1 Thess. 5:1-11

The math:

The 1st Nisan in the twentieth year of Artaxerxes (the edict to rebuild Jerusalem) was 14th March, B. C. 445. The 10th Nisan in Passion Week (Christ's entry into Jerusalem) was 6th April, A. D. 32. The intervening period was 476 years and 24 days (the days being reckoned inclusively, as required by the language of the prophecy, and in accordance with the Jewish practice).

But  $476 \times 365 = 173,740$  days

Add (14 March to 6th April, both inclusive) 24 days

Add for leap years 116 days

Equals a total of 173,880 days.

And 69 weeks of prophetic years of 360 days as both the Babylonian and Jews reckoned them (or  $69 \times 7 \times 360$ ) a total of 173,880 days.

Note; in reckoning years from B. C. to A. D., one year must always be omitted; for it is obvious that from B. C. 1 to A. D. 1 was not two years, but one year. B. C. 1 ought to be described as B. C. "0", and it is so reckoned by astronomers, who would describe the historical date B. C. 445, as 444.
